It is very unfortunate for all of us that the pandemic has interfered with our children savouring in full measure the educational experience. However, we began our classes bang on time, albeit virtually. We reached devices braving all odds to teachers across the city to support the online mode of teaching-learning. **All classes, curricular and co-curricular, are being done virtually.** We were one of the first schools in the city to commit to and begin online education this year. We are also perhaps a rare school which taught eye exercises to kids.

A significant number of our support staff were present and working during the lockdown to attend to essential maintenance and sanitisation and have worked diligently to keep the premises clean throughout the lockdown period. In fact, some of them stayed away for months from their families. Post lockdown, as more number of members have started coming to the school for work, stricter measures are being taken to ensure safety. Elaborate and scientific steps have been put into practice for everyone to follow to maintain the pristine quality of the buildings and campus. This has been intimated earlier to you.

As is customary with us, we had sent out a circular in the month of December requesting for a modest increase in the fees for the new session to which none had expressed any concerns. However, responding to the unusual situation that the pandemic has put us into, our fees have been rolled back to that of the last session 2019-20. The extra fees paid by you in April have also been adjusted equally over the remaining 11 months.

Further, the bus contractor has reduced the bus charges from May 2020. Bus users would be aware of this.

Our caring teachers and staff are waiting eagerly to welcome our dear children physically back to school. Going forward, we wish to assure you that we are together as a family in fighting this new battle. You can always reach out to the school and we will always do the best we possibly can.
